



# Northern Haiti Sustainability Initiative

On March 18, 2023, Cole and Craig Bramley will be participating in the **Selma to Montgomery 51-mile bike race** that commemorates Martin Luther King, Jr.'s 1965 5-day march that directly led to the passage of the 1965 Voting Rights Act. The historic significance of this race, alongside the fact that Haiti was the **first black colony in the world** to achieve independence (1804) underscores one of Martin Luther King's sayings,

*"There comes a time when one must take a position that is neither safe, nor politic, nor popular, but he must take it because conscience tells him it is right".*

The relatively miniscule positive effects of the literally billions of dollars donated to Haiti over the past decades make it hard for many to see Haiti as a worthwhile place to donate their dollars or efforts. We cannot argue with that fact. That being said, every dollar donated to NHSI goes directly to our remote Northern Haitian School. **We are proud** of the positive impact that NHSI has had, not only for the school, but for the Laguille Community.
